**II INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF HISTORIANS  
"HISTORY, CULTURE AND NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY"**



The Union of Cuban Historians (UNHIC), co-sponsored by the Academy of the History of Cuba, the Institute of the History of Cuba, the Office of Historical Affairs of the Presidency of the Republic, the Center of Studies about José Martí, the University of Havana and the University of Oriente, are calling historians and specialists of related disciplines to participate in the II International Conference of Historians "History, Culture and National Sovereignty", as part of the program of the V International Conference "For a balanced world", to be held in Havana, from January the 25th till the 28th, 2022, organized by the Project "Jose Martí of international solidarity".

The aim of the Conference is to promote an exchange and a wide and plural debate concerning the contribution of science and conscience of history, historians, investigators, professors, activists and promoters, with the universal and collective task of building a better world. We are interested in exchanging on the activity of the historian, and that the Conference could be a space to announce new studies and historic, pedagogical and methodological results.

We propose the following exchange topics:

- José Martí, the concept of the balance of the world and Our America.
- Vision on the integration processes in Latin America. Historicity and current situation
- Our America: Independence and Revolution.
- Cuba and the world in contemporary history.
- The historic criticism. Paradigms and challenges.
- The teaching of history. Theoretical and methodological issues.
- The formation of historians. Experiences and challenges.
- Experiences in the socialization of the historical knowledge. History in the publishing world and the alternatives of new technologies.
- Importance of the historical memory in the formation of the individual and for the social development.

The participants in the Conference will be considered to be delegates to the V Conference and they will have the right to take part in all the commissions, conferences and other scientific spaces of the program, as well as in the included cultural and parallel activities.

The scientific program will be based on papers, and for presentations the authors will have up to 20 minutes. The participation will have the modalities of speaker and participant. The registration of interested participants in being in one or another modality can be done straight the Organizing Committee of this II Conference.

The participants interested in presenting papers to II Conference "HISTORY, CULTURE AND NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY" will have to send their papers to the Organizing Committee until November the 30th, 2021, to the e-mail address: [unhic-cuba@cubarte.cult.cu](mailto:unhic-cuba@cubarte.cult.cu). They should observe the following requisites:  
Title of the work. Abstract of up to 250 words in Spanish language.

Full name of the author. Scientific degree. Institution to which the author belongs. City, country. E-mail address.

All the speakers must present, at the registration of the Conference, the printed text of the papers, which will be delivered to the Organizing Committee, on sheet size of 8.5 x 11" together with a digital copy in Word format.

REGISTRATION: The participants in the II International Conference of Historians "History, Culture and National Sovereignty" will also be registered as delegates to the V International Conference "For a Balanced World", and they will only pay for the registration of the V Conference:

120.00 USD for delegates and 50.00 USD for companions. Undergraduate students will only pay 70.00 USD. The payment can be done in the Palace of the Conventions, in Havana, at the moment of registration, or via online in the official web site of the event:
