- 5. Social justice, participatory democracy and popular participation.
- 5. Literature, culture, and politics in Jose Marti's vision: reflections for the 21st century.
- 6. Education, university and journalism in Jose Marti's ideology.
- 7. Martí: Philosophy, interculturality, nature and humanism.
